

2024 was a groundbreaking year for the Kingsley Obiukwu Foundation (KOF), marked by initiatives that bridged gaps in food security, unified people, celebrated sportsmanship, and set the stage for transformative events in 2025 and beyond. The Foundation's projects exemplified its commitment to fostering unity, empowering communities, and driving positive change across Nnewi and beyond. Key highlights of the year include: the Unity Cup, Food Support Outreach, and the meticulous planning for the inaugural Unity Marathon & Festival.

II. Key Highlights

Unity Cup 2024

The Kingsley Obiukwu Foundation Unity Cup united the 10 towns of Nnewi South LGA in a thrilling football competition, fostering sportsmanship, collaboration, and local pride. The event culminated in a grand finale attended by thousands, leaving a lasting legacy of community spirit.

Food Outreach

Over two phases in 2024, the Foundation distributed more than 7,000 bags of rice, providing critical food relief to thousands of families in the 10 towns across Nnewi South LGA. This initiative particularly targeted vulnerable populations, including the elderly and women ensuring no one was left behind.

Unity Marathon & Festival

Held on January 2, 2025, the Unity Marathon & Festival was the culmination of months of preparation in 2024. With over 1,500 attendees, the event celebrated unity, inclusivity, and cultural heritage, highlighting the Foundation's ability to bring people together from across Nigeria.



III. Major Initiatives and Impact

The Kingsley Obiukwu Foundation's 2024 initiatives embodied its mission to unite, empower, and uplift communities. Each program tackled critical needs such as food security, youth engagement, unity, peace, and social cohesion, leaving a lasting impact on Nnewi South, Nnewi North, Ekwusigo LGA and beyond.



The Challenge

Food insecurity remains a pressing issue for vulnerable populations in many communities. Recognizing this urgent need, the Kingsley Obiukwu Foundation (KOF) launched two food outreach programs in 2024, providing immediate relief to families in Nnewi South LGA. These initiatives were designed to be inclusive, ensuring that no one was left behind, with a particular focus on the elderly, who often face greater barriers to accessing essential resources.

Timeline and **Execution**

- First Outreach (March 30, 2024): 5,000 bags of rice were distributed across 10 towns in Nnewi South LGA.
- Second Outreach (June 29, 2024): An additional 5,000 bags of rice were distributed to the same 10 towns.

Key Details

Total Distribution:

Distributed a total of **10,000 bags** of rice.



Focus Groups: Priority was given to families facing financial hardships, women and elderly residents.



Selection process: Beneficiaries were chosen through a transparent balloting system, overseen by community youth leaders and external student volunteers, ensuring fairness and equity.





Participating Towns: Amichi, Akwa-Ihedi, Azigbo, Ebenator, Ezinifite, Ekwulumili, Osumenyi, Ukpor, Unubi, Utuh. Logistics: Community leaders coordinated distribution efforts, with local security and vigilante groups engaged to ensure a safe and orderly process.

Impact

The 2024 Food Support Outreach by the Kingsley Obiukwu Foundation played a crucial role in addressing food insecurity, providing immediate relief to vulnerable households, and fostering long-term community resilience. Beyond distributing food, the initiative created economic benefits, strengthened social structures, and reinforced community trust, contributing to sustainable transformation in Nnewi South LGA.

The Kingsley Obiukwu Foundation envisions a future where no family in Nnewi South LGA and beyond faces food insecurity. By shifting from short-term relief to sustainable impact, the Foundation aims to build self-reliant communities, ensuring economic resilience, social inclusion, and long-term food security for all. Through continuous innovation, collaboration, and community-driven solutions, KOF remains committed to uplifting lives and fostering lasting transformation.

The Challenge

Youth engagement remains a significant challenge in many communities, with limited opportunities for sports, leadership development, and constructive activities. A lack of structured recreational programs can lead to increased crime, social fragmentation, and unfulfilled potential among young people. Recognizing the need for unity, youth empowerment, and community-driven engagement, the Kingsley Obiukwu Foundation launched the Unity Cup 2024, a grassroots football tournament designed to foster peace, social cohesion, and economic opportunities across Nnewi South LGA.

Timeline and Execution

• Kick-off Date: August 10, 2024

• Grand Finale: September 8, 2024

Tournament Format: Group stage, semi-finals, and a grand final match between communities.

Key Details

- Participating Teams/Towns: Amichi, Akwa-Ihedi, Azigbo, Ebenator, Ezinifite, Ekwulumili, Osumenyi, Ukpor, Unubi, and Utuh.
- **Grand Finale Venue:** St. Anthony of Padua Field, Osumenyi, attracting a crowd of over 3,000 spectators, including dignitaries, local leaders, and football enthusiasts.
- Security & Logistics: Community leaders and local security outfits ensured a safe and orderly execution of matches.

Tournament Results:

Champion: Ukpor Town

Runner-Up: Unubi Town

Building on the success of the 2024 Unity Cup, KOF is committed to expanding its impact by:

Scaling the Tournament

- Expand participation to include additional LGAs, increasing youth engagement and talent discovery.
- Introducing Sustainable Youth Development Initiatives: Introduce football training camps and mentorship programs to develop skills beyond the tournament.
- Fostering Public-Private Partnerships to invest in grassroots sports development and establish permanent youth sports initiatives.

LONG-TERM VISION

The long-term vision for the Unity Cup is to establish it as a sustainable platform for youth empowerment, community development, and economic growth. The Kingsley Obiukwu Foundation aims to expand the tournament to additional LGAs, develop structured training programs, and partner with national and international sports organizations to create career pathways for talented players.

Beyond football, the initiative will foster leadership, entrepreneurship, and life skills, ensuring youth engagement extends beyond the pitch. Investments in community sports infrastructure, scholarships, and year-round mentorship programs will further solidify the Unity Cup as a lasting force for unity, peacebuilding, and grassroots sports development.

Through strategic partnerships and continued expansion, the tournament will not only celebrate sportsmanship but also drive long-term economic and social transformation in Nnewi South LGA and beyond.

UNITY MARATHON & FESTIVAL 2025

A CULMINATION OF 2024 EFFORTS

While this event occurred on January 2, 2025, it was a direct outcome of the meticulous planning, collaboration, and efforts throughout 2024

The Challenge

Insecurity and social fragmentation have long limited opportunities for public gatherings, tourism, and economic activities in Nnewi South, weakening community identity and engagement. Without structured, safe, and inclusive events, local communities remain disconnected from the broader national landscape. Recognizing this, the Kingsley Obiukwu Foundation (KOF) launched the Unity Marathon & Festival, not just as a race, but as a transformative event aimed at fostering social cohesion, economic revitalization, and national engagement. This initiative opened up Nnewi South and neighboring LGAs to Nigeria and Nigeria to them, instilling a sense of security and pride, which is critical to fostering thriving, resilient communities. Beyond fitness, marathons serve as powerful platforms for community engagement, economic stimulation, and national integration, making them a catalyst for lasting impact.

Timeline and Execution

Planning & Stakeholder Engagement (2024)

- Route Design & Logistics: An 8km course mapped from St. Mary's Catholic Church, Ukpor, to St. Anthony of Padua, Osumenyi, passing 13 key landmarks to improve visibility and accessibility.
- Security Measures: Coordinated with national, state, and local law enforcement agencies, vigilante groups, the Federal Road Safety Corps (FRSC), and medical personnel to ensure a safe and well-monitored event.
- Inclusivity & Nationwide Participation: Participants from across Nigeria, making the event a symbol of national unity.
- Community Stakeholder Engagement: Success was driven by collaboration with key stakeholders, including:
 - Youth leaders from Nnewi South, Nnewi North, and Ekwusigo LGAs.`
 - National, state, and local government authorities, law enforcement, and medical personnel to ensure safety and inclusivity.
 - Student volunteers, who played critical roles in logistics, crowd management, and participant support.

Race Day: January 2, 2025

- Over 1,000 runners from across Nigeria gathered at Ukpor for the marathon's energetic kickoff.
- Cheering spectators and traditional music and dance, created an atmosphere of unity, safety, and shared identity.
- Finish Line & Unity Festival: The post-race festival at St. Anthony of Padua, Osumenyi, featured local food, cultural performances, and networking opportunities, reinforcing the spirit of togetherness.

Prize Structure

- \1 million each for the first male and female winners.
- \\$100,000 each for 10 runner ups
- \\$50,000 each for the top five indigene winners from Nnewi South, Nnewi North, and Ekwusigo LGAs.
- Special Recognition Awards for elderly participants

Key Details

On January 2, 2025, the Unity Marathon & Festival began with an electrifying start as over 1,000 runners gathered at St. Mary's Catholic Church, Ukpor, full of anticipation and energy.

The Marathon

The Marathon brought the scenic route to life, with cheering spectators and cultural displays creating a vibrant and celebratory atmosphere. Runners navigated through key landmarks, demonstrating resilience, determination, and unity. Inclusivity was at the heart of the event, as the first male winner hailed from Plateau State and the first female winner from Abia State, underscoring the marathon's national reach beyond Nnewi.

Traditional music, dance, and local cuisine brought communities together, reinforcing the Kingsley Obiukwu Foundation's mission to foster unity through shared experiences. Additionally, KOF will work towards securing corporate sponsorships to ensure the marathon's continued growth and reach, allowing for greater impact in future editions.

KOF aims to establish annual business exhibitions and networking opportunities alongside the festival, introducing scholarships and entrepreneurship grants linked to marathon participation. The Foundation will also advocate for local infrastructure development, including road improvements and hospitality investments, in preparation for future events.

The Unity Marathon & Festival is poised to become a flagship annual event, reinforcing Nnewi South as a center for sports, tourism, economic empowerment, and cultural celebration. With continued expansion, this event will showcase the power of unity, resilience, and collective progress, transforming Nnewi South into a thriving hub for national and international engagement.

Champion Football Team of the Unity Cup – Youth leader (Ukpor Town):



For the young athletes of Ukpor, the Unity Cup 2024 was an extraordinary opportunity to bring pride to their community. Despite limited resources, the team's determination and teamwork shone through as they advanced through the competition. Their hard work culminated in a thrilling victory in the final match, where they defeated Unubi 3–0 to claim the championship.

"The Unity Cup wasn't just about football—it was about bringing our town together for the first time in years after insecurity had divided us" said Chidi, Ukpor's youth leader. leader.

The tournament fostered collaboration and sportsmanship, as youth leaders from all 10 participating towns—Amichi, Akwa-Ihedi, Azigbo, Ebenator, Ezinifite, Ekwulumili, Osumenyi, Ukpor, Unubi, and Utuh—came together to coordinate teams, promote fair play, and restore a sense of unity. Through football, teamwork, and shared purpose, the Unity Cup reignited hope and community spirit in Ukpor and beyond.



Triumph at the Marathon – Afigbo Esther (1st Female Winner, \frac{\text{\text{\text{\text{Million Prize}}}}

Afigbo Esther, a dedicated long-distance runner from Abia State, entered the Kingsley Obiukwu Foundation Unity Marathon & Festival with a fierce determination to prove herself. Competing against seasoned athletes from across Nigeria, she pushed her limits and emerged as the first female winner, claiming the *1 million grand prize.

"I still can't believe it! I came here just to run my best race, but winning felt like a dream. The energy from the crowd, the cheers, and the support along the way gave me the extra push I needed. This moment will stay with me forever." - Afigbo Esther

Esther's victory is a testament to perseverance, dedication, and the spirit of inclusivity that the marathon represents. Her success not only celebrates personal achievement but also inspires other young women to take on challenges, break barriers, and believe in their potential.

Supporting the Elderly – Grace Okeke (Amichi Town)

At 72 years old, Mrs. Grace Okeke, a widow from Amichi, has spent years navigating life alone, relying on occasional support from neighbors. With no steady source of income, affording basic necessities became increasingly difficult. When the Kingsley Obiukwu Foundation Food Support Outreach reached Amichi, Grace was among the elderly beneficiaries prioritized for relief. She received a 5kg bag of rice twice, significantly easing her struggle to secure food.

"This rice means so much to me. It's not just about eating every day—it's a reminder that someone cares. I also don't have to worry about food for a few months" she expressed in Igbo, overwhelmed with gratitude.

Grace's story reflects the profound impact of the Food Support Outreach, ensuring that the elderly and most vulnerable members of the community receive timely and much-needed relief.

Volunteer Coordinator – Somto Foster Ndiomaluke:



Somto, a dedicated university student, has played a key role in the Kingsley Obiukwu Foundation's initiatives, ensuring that volunteers are well-organized, trained, and effectively deployed across various programs. Volunteers are the backbone of the Foundation's success. Ensuring they are adequately trained, supported, and recognized will build a stronger, more efficient team. Introducing training modules, providing pre-event briefings, and establishing clear role descriptions will empower volunteers to perform confidently.

Community Engagement and Awareness

Effective engagement with local communities is key to fostering trust and enthusiasm. Involving residents in planning and creating awareness campaigns ahead of events ensures smoother execution and increased participation.

Building Weather-Resilient Contingency Plans

The need for flexibility in response to unexpected weather conditions became evident. Developing backup plans, such as alternative venues or schedules, will minimize disruptions and ensure continuity, regardless of external circumstances.
